Asdepiadacene

CALOTROPIS

Vessels medium-sized to small; often with extremely small, tracheid-like groups associated with the larger vessels; with numerous multiples of 4 or more cells. perforations simple. Intervascular pitting alternate and rather large; vestured, pits to ray cells similar. Mean member length 0.2-0.26 mm.

<u>Parenchyma</u> usually sparse and associated with the vessels; v_a sicentric and diffuse in Calotropis. Strands mostly of 2-4 cells.

Rays typically narrow, less than 4 cells wide; less than 1 mm high; about 15-20 per mm; heterogeneous with 5-10 marginal rows of upright cells; sometimes composed entirely of upright cells.

Fibres with thin walls; mean length 0.3.0.75 mm.
